## AFSC 2015 Ice Show

**Show Dates:** Saturday, May 2, 2015 @ 6:00pm  
& Sunday, May 3, 2015 @ 2:00pm

Welcome to the 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual AFSC Spring Ice Show. In order to put on a good show and let everybody know what the rules are ahead of time, a lot of important information appears below. Please read it carefully and save this letter for future reference.

**ALL REHEARSALS ARE MANDATORY.** ICE TIME IS EXPENSIVE. THE AMES FIGURE SKATING CLUB AND YOUR FELLOW SKATERS ARE COUNTING ON YOU. PLEASE ARRIVE 15 MINUTES BEFORE YOUR PRACTICE TIME, PUT YOUR SKATES ON AND BE READY TO GET ON THE ICE.

**Absences:** If you miss one rehearsal for a number and wish to remain in that number, you must contact the Show Chair Tiffini Davies (515-230-2627) or Vicki Koehn (810-429-4555) **AND** the coach of the number prior to the rehearsal to notify them of your absence, and you must arrange and pay for a private lesson with the coach to learn the missed material. If you miss more than one rehearsal for any number you may be unable to participate in that number, and you are still responsible for the costume cost.

**E-mail:** Important information is distributed via e-mail, sometimes with no more than 24 hours notice. **Make sure you check your email daily!** If you do not have email access, please contact the Show Chair.

**Fees:** A skater cannot practice until all fees including registration, tickets, costumes, and sponsorship requirements are paid.

**Tickets:** All families are required to sell six (6) tickets to the show. Additional tickets will be available at the Information Table during rehearsals. Everyone attending the show must have a ticket (adults and school age children). Ticket money for extra tickets is due no later than May 1<sup>st</sup>, but can be turned in anytime at the Information Table.

- **Ticket prices \$8.**
- **Discounted ticket price of \$5 for seniors (60 & older) available only at the door.**
- **Discounted ticket price of \$5 for students (with ID) available only at the door.**
- **Children under 5 are free.**
- **Each registered skater will receive one VIP ticket good for both performances.**

**Sponsors:** Each skater (family) is required to recruit sponsorship in the total of \$50 or be willing to pay \$50. The contact form from the sponsor and payments must be returned by April 5<sup>th</sup>. The skater will be credited with 10% of sponsorship money above \$50 on costume pick-up day. The more you raise the more of a discount you receive. Additional sponsorship forms are available at the rink or contact the sponsorship chair.

**Costumes:** Costume Pick-up date and time will be announced in the near future. The total balance due on costumes must be paid when the costumes are picked up. Information on hair and make-up will be distributed with the costumes.

**Pictures:** Pictures will be taken at the Ice Arena on April 16<sup>th</sup>. Group pictures will be included in the show program. We need your smiling face even if you are not planning to purchase any photos. At this time you will also have the opportunity to purchase individual pictures, with hair, costume, etc. arranged as you choose. **Picture night schedules will follow at a later date.**

**Cast Party:** The Cast Party will be held on Sunday evening, May 4<sup>th</sup> after the show, once tear-down is complete. Everyone is requested to help with tear-down so we can all get to the cast party. Reservations are necessary and can be made at the Information Table during rehearsal times. More information on this fun get-together will be available at a later date.

**Video:** Show video and DVD will be available for purchase. Camcorders and flash cameras are not allowed during the performances. Camcorders are allowed during dress rehearsal. Video orders are due May 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Personal ads:** Personal ads are available in the program for \$5 per ad. This is a great way to encourage your skater. The deadline for personal ads is March 13<sup>th</sup>. **Fundraisers:**

**\*Cupcakes:** the order form is included in packet. Orders are due February 2<sup>nd</sup> and the pick-up date is Wednesday evening, February 11<sup>th</sup>.

**Parents:** Please stay in the stands, not behind the boards, during all rehearsals. You get a better view this way.

**Information Table:** Committee members will staff the Information Table during rehearsals to answer questions. Additional tickets, posters, video forms, party sign-up, etc. will be available at this table.

**Day of Show Warm-Up:** There will be an opportunity for skaters to warm up sometime in the period two hours to one-half hour prior to the show. Specific times will be posted the week prior to show.

**Mandatory 1<sup>st</sup> half Practice:** Tuesday night, April 28<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 pm

**Mandatory 2<sup>nd</sup> half Practice:** Wednesday and Thursday night (April 29<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup>) at 5:30 pm

**Mandatory Dress Rehearsal:** Friday night, May 1<sup>st</sup> at 6:00 pm
